I would like to thank all whanau for their amazing support this term at all the sporting events that Te Maturanga has participated in. It is awesome to hear the cheering from the sidelines.

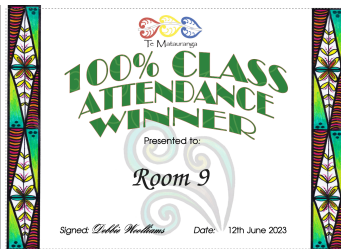
I would like to give a special thank you to Mrs Idirisova who organises all the teams and teachers for different sports.
