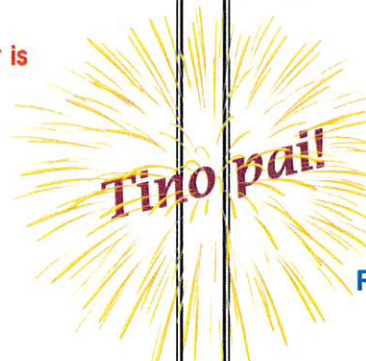


Attendance
