Thank you to all parents/caregivers that attended Parent/Teacher Interviews last night.

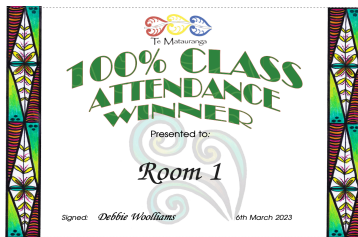
As a school we value your input into your child/childrens learning.
