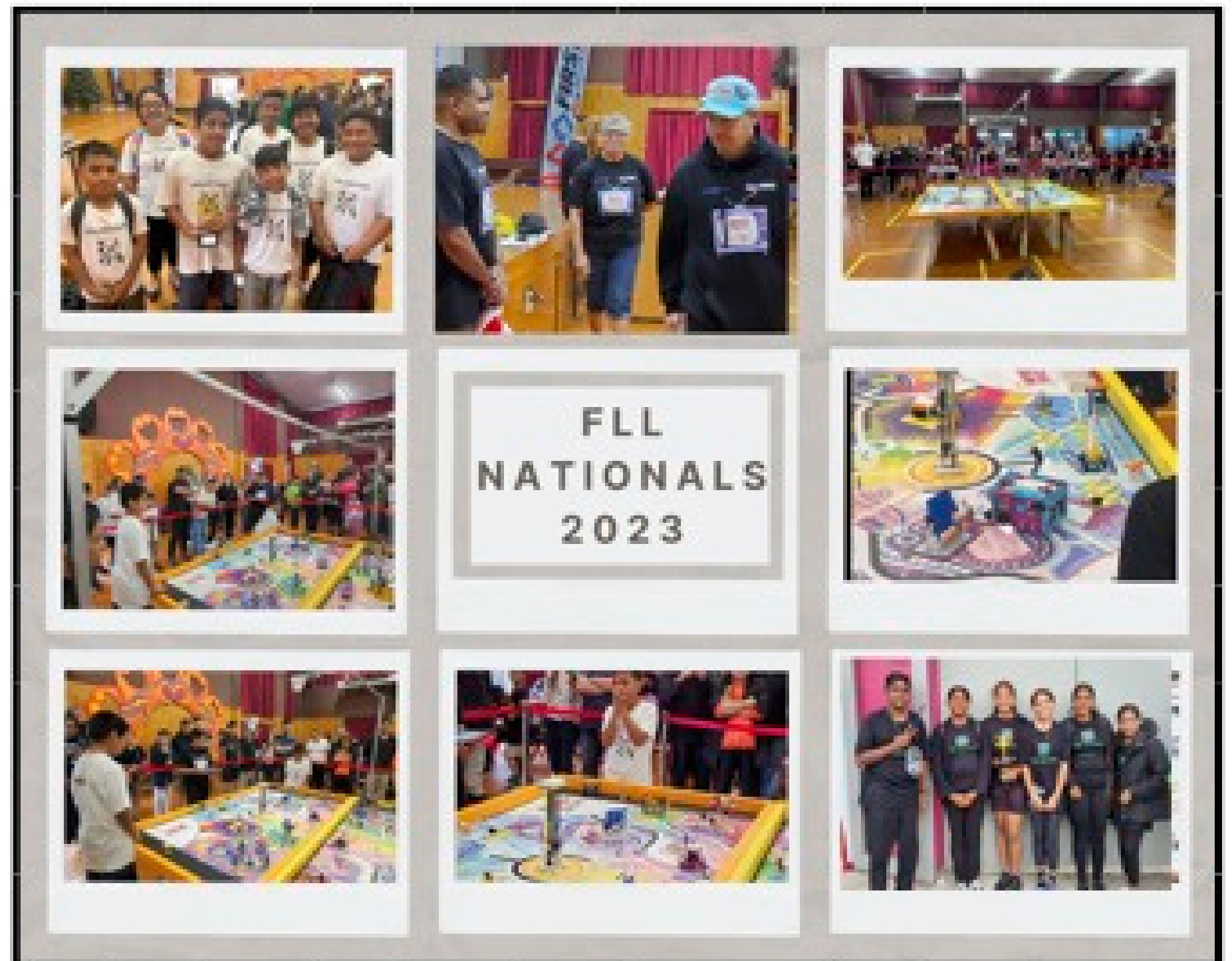


Last weekend 3 teams represented Te Matauranga
